28-Day Read-Aloud Challenge

1. Kids Read Aloud

The goal is for each student to read aloud for at least 10 minutes per day. They can read to anyone: a sibling, a grandma, a stuffed animal, a pet...

Pre-readers can look at pictures and tell a story aloud, rather than reading the actual words.

Print a calendar for each student in your family. Every day the student reads aloud for at least 10 minutes, they should mark an X and have a parent initial their calendar.

2. Celebrate (and Win Prizes!)

Celebrate your students' success! Make sure to do something fun as a family to celebrate finishing the challenge.

What sounds fun? A trip to the bookstore or local public library? A movie night? A family sleepover in the living room? Do something as a family to celebrate finishing the challenge!

Completed calendars should be returned to the homeroom teacher by Thursday, March 1st. Anyone who reads aloud at least 25 days in February will be eligible to win prizes in a drawing that will take place on Monday, March 5th, during our regular Monday Morning Assembly.
