

MILK MONEY FOR MANTO

Dear Parents and Students,

For the past 13 years, our parish has supported two nutritional programs, called "Milk Lines". These milk lines are located in the rural, mountainous towns of Manto and Guarizama, Honduras. They provide a hot meal, consisting of rice, a tortilla, and a glass of milk, along with basic catechesis to over 200 children per week. Approximately \$7,500 a year is required to keep these milk lines running.

This year, each classroom will have a donation tub to collect money to help support the milk lines in Honduras. We ask that your child donates to these containers during this time of giving thanks. Any type of money is acceptable; coins, cash or checks.

Our goal is to raise at least \$7,500 in order to support the milk lines for another year. Hang this flyer on the refrigerator or in any obvious spot to act as a daily reminder.
